

• Adult Coed Soccer

Teams will play 8 league games on local fields beginning the first week of April. Games will be held on Sundays throughout the day. League fees will include officials, field prep/lights and play-offs for qualifying teams. Home team will furnish the game ball. Three divisions offered: Competitive, Rec-Open and Rec-Over 30. The Rec-Open and Rec-Over 30 will be combined if not enough teams. Teams will need to field 5 women and 5 men - goalie can be either gender. Players must be at least 18 years of age and out of high school. Maximum of 16 teams.
