## Proposition 1: Replacement Educational Programs & Operation Levy

- 2-year replacement levy to provide 20 percent of funding not covered by the state.
- Not a new tax. Significant tax decrease beginning in 2019.
- Levy amount: \$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed property value.

## How levy dollars are spent

The Replacement Educational Programs & Operation Levy helps fund:



- Health, safety and security
- Operations, maintenance, grounds, utilities
- Student transportation



- Teachers, paraeducators, nurses, librarians, counselors, support personnel
- Instructional materials and supplies



- Arts, music, theater
- Extracurricular activities and athletics



- Special education programs



- Staff training and development

## How levy dollars are collected

If approved by voters, the two-year Replacement Programs & Operation Levy of **\$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed property value will generate up to approximately:**



For a property owner with an assessed value of \$300,000, this equals approximately \$450 annually, or \$37.50 a month.

## Changes to state school levy funding

While the 2017 state Legislature made significant investments in basic education, it's still a work in progress and actual costs are not fully covered. Through levies, school districts still need to bridge the gap between what the state pays for basic education and the actual cost. With new state requirements associated with levy funding, school districts will be limited in the amount of funding asked of voters in local levies.

Replacement Instructional Technology Improvements Levy



## Proposition 2: Replacement Instructional Technology Improvements Levy

- 6-year replacement levy to maintain 1:1 Technology Initiative, provide support and training and improve secure and reliable operations and infrastructure.
- This replacement levy is not a new tax.
- Levy amount: Average estimated rate \$0.47 per \$1,000 of assessed property value.

## How levy dollars are spent

The Replacement Instructional Technology Improvements Levy helps fund:



Maintenance of 1:1 digital device ratio: Provides every student equitable access to technology with Chromebooks that enhance learning and prepares students for the careers of tomorrow.



Technical support and training: Offers best practices in technology integration for teachers to deliver relevant and personalized learning experiences for every student.



Secure and reliable operations: Improves and maintains operations, infrastructure, licenses and internet access for students and teachers; expanded wireless network.

## How levy dollars are collected

If approved by voters, the six-year Replacement Instructional Technology Improvements Levy will average **\$0.47 per \$1,000 of assessed property value, which will generate:**



For a property owner with an assessed value of \$300,000, the average rate would equal approximately \$141 annually or \$11.75 a month.
